GENERAL RULES:

- Rider age as of January 1, 2020. Horse age as of December 31, 2020.
- 2. Walk Trot participants may only show in the designated Walk Trot classes and Halter classes.
- 3. Walk Trot Gymkhana: if horse break into a lope for 3 consecutive strides they are disqualified from the event.
- 4. Walk Trot 16+ show clothes are optional.
- 5. Pony height requirement is 14.0 hands (56") and under.
- 6. All stallions must be shown by an adult 18 year or older.
- 7. ALL riders 19 and under must wear an ASTM/SEI helmet when riding in Gymkhana and English classes.
- 8. Pee Wee or Lead line classes are available for 5-7 year olds. Lead line participants can participate in Pee Wee Showmanship but may not participate in the Pee Wee Walk or Walk Trot classes.
- 9. The show committee reserves the right to combine or spilt any classes.
- 10. The show committee reserves the right to require exhibitors or horse's proof of age if there is a dispute.
- 11. As per Michigan law all horses must have a current year's copy of a negative Coggins test.

DAILY HIGH POINT RULES:

- 1. There is no daily High Point fee.
- 2. Must identify highpoint section on entry form.
- 3. One horse, one rider combination.
- 4. One high point and one reserve high point is awarded in each designated division
- 5. Points will be calculated from the best points within one like class in Halter, Showmanship, English Pleasure, English Equitation, Western Pleasure and Western Horsemanship.
- 6. Grand and Reserve, trail, reining and Pee Wee classes are NOT eligible for daily high point.
- 7. In the event of a tie breaker, the rider with the most 1st places wins and if still tied the judge may ask exhibitors a question regarding horse knowledge.
