The Michigan 4-H State Awards Program is open to 4-H members who are 13-19 years old with three or more years of 4H experience. To qualify for the award, 4-H'ers must submit a written application that showcases the learning experiences, knowledge and skills they've acquired through their participation in $4-\mathrm{H}$, as well as their contributions to their local 4-H programs, clubs and communities. Submissions are reviewed by the Michigan 4-H State Awards selection committee. This group of volunteers, staff members and industry experts determine which members are selected as award finalists. All applicants receive written feedback from selection committees.

In addition to a plaque, each 4-H State Award winner in the senior division will also receive a $\$ 200$ cash award; junior winners receive $\$ 50$ cash awards. These awards are made possible by generous donations to the Michigan 4-H Foundation.
