Select the number of tickets you desire, click add to cart. The tickets will be added to your cart free of charge. Once they are added to you cart, click CHECKOUT.

When you click CHECKOUT, you will have to fill in some information in order to get the tickets sent to you. Fill out your first and last name, email, and phone number. In the space that says "Let's make it memorable. Name your event:" please type in your county followed by 4-H (ex. Ingham County 4-H).

Once you name your event you will need to fill in your address. When you fill out all the information on the screen click, CONFIRM.

After you click confirm you are all set! You will receive an email with your tickets. You can either scan your tickets off your phone once you arrive at the game or you can print them from your email and bring them to the game so tickets can be scanned at entry.

4-H Reenrollment Deadline—December 31, 2019

Log in to your <u>4HOnline</u> Family account to submit enrollment for each member of your family - participating Youth and Adults (*Adults only if a volunteer). All adult volunteers must be reenrolled by November 1.

Go to <u>http://mi.4honline.com</u> and select "I have a profile" and enter the email and password you created last year. If you've forgotten your password, select "I forgot my password" and follow the instructions. Once at your family homepage, work through each member's page to complete/update personal information, authorizations and project information. PLEASE MAKE SURE CLUB AND PROJECT INFORMATION IS UP TO DATE! Pay special attention to your "Years in 4-H" and be sure to add each project a member is/has been involved in.

There is no option to pay online. The participation annual fee for **\$20 per individual**/ **\$60 per family** will still be collected by club leaders. **Reenrollment deadline is December 31, 2019.** If needed, scholarships are available. Please contact the 4-H Office for details.



Community Leaders: Please make sure to have your club participation fees paid by the end of the year. Please remember that reenrolled members will remain as pending until payment is received in the 4-H Office.
