Log in to your <u>4HOnline</u> Family account to submit enrollment for each member of your family - participating Youth and Adults (\*Adults only if a volunteer). All adult volunteers must be reenrolled by November 1.

Go to <a href="http://mi.4honline.com">http://mi.4honline.com</a> and select "I have a profile" and enter the email and password you created last year. If you've forgotten your password, select "I forgot my password" and follow the instructions. Once at your family homepage, work through each member's page to complete/update personal information, authorizations and project information. PLEASE MAKE SURE CLUB AND PROJECT INFORMATION IS UP TO DATE! Pay special attention to your "Years in 4-H" and be sure to add each project a member is/has been involved in.

There is no option to pay online. The participation annual fee for \$20 per individual/
\$60 per family will still be collected by club leaders. Reenrollment deadline is

**December 31, 2019.** If needed, scholarships are available. Please contact the 4-H Office for details.

#### **General Jackpot Rules**

- eneral Jackpot Rulles

  Open to all youth to 21 years old as of 01/1/2020, as long as they can maintain animal control.

  Entry Fee: \$356head postmarked by December 15, 2019 \$50/head day of show. MSYC sanctioned Shows.

  Entry fee required for each day exhibitors shows.

  Jackpot showmanship classes offered for pee wee, 8-11, 12-14, 15-17 and 18-21 years of age. Awards for showmanship will be given. \$10 entry fee.

  Pens will be provided for all animals at a fee of \$5.00 per pen (holds one animal). Exhibitors are responsible for providing wood shavings. Ghavings on site for purchase) 1 animal per pen. Tack stalls available for the same \$5 fee. No showing off trailers per fair rules. One fee for the entire weekend.
- The total number of animals entered will determine the number of classes and class sizes. Animals will
- Classes will be determined by individual animal weight and the total number of animals. No minimum weight
- Only barrows and gitts will be allowed in hog classes. Purebreds will show by breed with a minimum of 5 needed for a breed. (Purebred Papers required) if there are not enough for a breed, purebreds will show in a AOB class. Breeding class gith (No weight limit) brities will have to pay dual entry fee if showing in market class. Champion Breeding gitt will not participate in overall. Overall Champion Breeding git payout of \$100.
- The top three hogs will be re-weighed in class. Hogs weighing more or less than 10 lbs above or below the declared weight will be disqualified from the show and all other hogs will move up one placing in class.
- Hogs must have a premise ID (840) tag. All out of state livestock must have health papers available at check
- All decisions made by Michigan Kickoff Jackpot Committee are final.
