## 4-H Market Plan

- Make a project that you would like to sell
- Keep track of the time that it takes to complete
- Keep track of all expenses/costs for the project
- Download the "4-H Market Plan" form
- Write down all costs and time on the form
- Fill in all information about your project
- Write your buyer's letter
- Write your thank you note
- Complete a "4-H Market Plan" for each project that you wish to sell
- If you are not sure that a project will earn a blue ribbon, complete a "4-H Market Plan" for an additional project as a back up


## Entering your projects in Entrepreneurship

- Enter your project/s in the appropriate department in the Fair book
- Also, enter 1 or 2 projects in the Fair book under the 4-H Personal Development Department, Entrepreneurship
- Follow all instructions for your project/s
- Have the project judged
- Follow the Ingham County Fair book (on line) for times and places
- If you achieve a "blue" ribbon rank for the project, take the " $4-H$ Market Plan" for the project to the Terry Brail Community Bldg., on Saturday, July 30 from 11 am to 5 pm to be judged
- All parts of the "4-H Market Plan" must be completed in order to be judged
- Do not bring your project to the Entrepreneurship judging
- Place your project and the "4-H Market Plan" in the 4-H Still Life Sale area


## Preparing for the Ingham County 4-H Still Life Sale

- Contact your potential buyers using your Buyer's Letter from your "4-H Market Plan"
- Display your project and Market Plan in the 4-H Still Life Sale area during the Fair
- Display your project in an attractive and interesting way
- Present your project at the 4-H Still Life Sale on Wednesday evening, August 3 at 6 pm
