



Recent Amendments to Rule 312 IAC 6.2

- Section 2: Adding/Revising Definitions for:
 - 1) Baseline volume abandonment
 - 2) Discontinued SWWF
 - 3) Salmonid Stream
- Section 3: Sale or Transfer of All or Portion of SWWF Baseline Volume
- Section 7: Identification of Voluntary Conservation and Efficiency Objectives



Section 2: Definitions

- 2) "Baseline Volume Abandonment"- Voluntary and affirmative termination of baseline volume, but does not include nonuse of baseline volume unless SWWF is determined to be discontinued by IDNR.
- 7) "Discontinued SWWF"- Registered or Permitted SWWF that meets the following:
- (A) Withdrawal equipment has been removed or is in such a state of disrepair for continuous period of more than 5 years; and (B) Owner not provided notice to IDNR of intent for future use.



Section 3: Baseline Volume Sale or Transfer

- (b) All or a portion of baseline volume (capacity/CU/ diversion) may be sold or transferred provided it is based on IDNR Status Determination or order.
- (g) Baseline volume shall be relinquished when SWWF is subject to baseline volume abandonment or is considered to be discontinued. Sale or transfer of all or a portion of SWWF baseline volume shall not be considered baseline volume abandonment.
