The June 1 Forms along with a copy of registration/identification papers, must be turned together, not individually, to the 4-H office **by June 1**. MSU Extension, 201 W. Kalamazoo, Suite 306, Kalamazoo, MI 49007

Please include a picture of right and left side of goat.

A Scrapie Tag attached to IDENTIFICATION PAPERS; Goat has a tattoo with FARM NUMBER and GOAT ID NUMBER that matches the Scrapie tag number. Tattoo is done by breeder in lieu of attaching the tag directly to the goat's ear. Tattooing must be done in the proper ears. (or tail web)

Tattoo numbers will be checked and must match the tag that is attached to your IDENTIFICATION PAPERS.

NOTE – You must keep the Scrapie Tag provided by the breeder, and present it on your ID Papers in order to get into the barn at fair

Registered Animals Only: If your goat is registered with an official national association breed registry (American Dairy Goat Association, National Pygmy Goat Association, American Boer Goat Association, etc.), they will have a tattoo. You must have the REGISTRATION PAPERS in your possession – tattoo must match the ID number on the Registration Papers. Due to the recommendation, from the Michigan State Vet found in the document above, microchips will not be allowed for tagging at the Kalamazoo County Youth Fair.
