## GENERAL INFORMATION

**EVENT THEME AND SERVICE PROJECT:** After nearly two years without face to face 4-H events, Spring Achievement is a fun and exciting way to “Step into 4-H” event and activities again. At this year’s event, we will also be taking a few steps back in time and will be opening a 4-H time capsule from many years ago. As a part of this year’s theme “Step into 4-H”, we will also be collecting tennis shoes (new or used in good condition) to be donated to those in need.

**PROGRAM COVER DESIGN CONTEST:** You have an opportunity to help design the event program cover and win some cash. Requirements: Design must be 4-H-related and include the event name (4-H Spring Achievement/Style Revue and Awards Ceremony), date (March 19, 2022) and 4-H clover. Covers should also incorporate this year’s theme (“Step into 4-H”). Designs should be on 8.5x11 paper. Put your name on the back. NEW THIS YEAR- Computer designs are allowed! Entries may be used for publicity. \$20 awarded to first place; \$10 to second place. Entries are due March 7<sup>th</sup>.

**REGISTRATION:** Registrations are due March 7<sup>th</sup>. **NO LATE REGISTRATIONS WILL BE ACCEPTED.** An accurate count of the projects is needed so scheduling of the judges can be completed. One registration form per 4-H member.

**ENTRY TAGS:** Each project needs an entry tag. Project tags will be available at the office or will be available at the event. Please arrive early if you need to tag your items the day of the event.

**ABSENTEE FORMS:** Members that cannot attend the event in person may still enter projects. You must attach a completed absentee form to each project. Forms are available at the office. Absentee Projects can be dropped off at the 4-H office on March 17<sup>th</sup> or 18<sup>th</sup> or at the event on March 19<sup>th</sup> by noon.

**CLOVER BUDS:** (Ages 5-8, as of Jan. 1) will be interviewed separately to ensure personal attention and encouragement. They will receive participation ribbons. Please take only 4 projects to a judge at a time. This reduces wait time for the Clover Buds.

**PUBLIC SPEAKING, DEMONSTRATIONS & PERFORMING ARTS:** All entrants will be contacted prior to the event and given appointment times for judging. The specific schedule will be determined by the number of entries. Registrations must include current phone numbers so the coordinator can contact you. Times: Maximum 5 minutes for individual entries and 10 minutes for group entries. You must furnish your own props, instruments, stands, tape/cd player, etc.

**FOOD:** There will be a soup and salad lunch available on-site and at no cost from 12:30 to 1:30. Please indicate on your registration if you plan to eat the soup and salad lunch. There is a McDonald’s and grocery store across the street. You may also pack your own lunch.

**AWARDS CEREMONY:** Tentatively planned to begin at 2:00pm. Style Revue Show, County Awards and Medals, Volunteer, Leader and Club Recognition. Every club will be invited to introduce themselves and share information about their club during the ceremony.

Registration Deadline and Cover Designs are Due by 4:30pm on **Monday, March 7<sup>th</sup>.**
