Dear 4-H Member:

You are receiving this letter because we would like to offer you the opportunity to apply for a Lapeer County 4-H scholarship for continuing education.

The Lapeer County 4-H Program has two scholarships available this year to assist 4-H'ers with continuing educational expenses:

- **4-H Council Scholarship** - open to all 4-H project areas
- **Tina Novotney Scholarship** - open to 4-H beef project area

Scholarships are a one-time award and may be used for any advanced schooling, including trade schools, technical programs, colleges, and junior colleges. Scholarship eligibility includes: a minimum 2.0 GPA, current enrollment and active participation in Lapeer County 4-H and minimum of at least four years participation in the Lapeer County 4-H program. Applicants must be a current graduating high school senior or graduated within the last 2 years at the time of application. All awards will require a paid enrollment receipt from the continuing education program.

Award winners will be announced during an awards ceremony at the Eastern Michigan State Fair in July. Youth that are unable to attend the awards ceremony will be notified after the event.

An application is attached. The completed application, including a current transcript from high school or post high-school program must be received by the Lapeer County MSU Extension office by 4:30p.m. Friday, **July 1**. Please email applications and accompanying materials to [graversa@msu.edu](mailto:graversa@msu.edu) or you may mail/drop off materials to Lapeer County MSU Extension. The office is open Monday-Friday from 8am to 4:30pm (closed from 12-1 for lunch). Please be aware that unexpected office closures may happen, and it is suggested to call ahead of time to confirm the office is open for drop off.

Please request your transcript from your school or program immediately to ensure you receive a copy before the application deadline. If you have any questions about your eligibility or completing the application, please contact me prior to June 27 to receive a timely response.
