- Completed 4-H projects in at least two project areas
- Completed at least one year as a teen leader
- Participated in 3 District (state sponsored) and/or State 4-H events
- Been recommended by his/her club leader

The above activities give you 50 points. You must earn at least 125 additional points and have a minimum of 175 points to be considered. The 4-H Key Club Award may be given to 1/2 of one percent of the total county membership. If more than 1/2 of one percent qualify for the award, those with the highest scores will be honored.
