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By the July STEER CHECK, these are the things that the Livestock Council Tagging Crew will be looking for:

- 1. Be able to lead the animal out of its pen to show the animal to tagging committee members.
- 2. Be able to use a show stick with the animal and show progress in skills at future steer checks.
- 3. Your steer should be able to be led by anyone. Continued progress with this goal will be evaluated at future steer checks.
- 4. Each steer should be equipped with its own show halter, show stick, lead ropes and plastic comb.
- 5. Steers will need to be exercised daily at the fair. These requirements are in place to prevent them from being a safety hazard to you or to others.
