The **STEER TAGGING COMMITTEE** will typically want to visit your property and tag your steer(s) on a **Saturday in January**. If necessary, they may have to change plans and complete this task on a weeknight.

By the July STEER CHECK, these are the things that the Livestock Council Tagging Crew will be looking for:

1. Be able to lead the animal out of its pen to show the animal to tagging committee members.
2. Be able to use a show stick with the animal and show progress in skills at future steer checks.
3. Your steer should be able to be led by anyone. Continued progress with this goal will be evaluated at future steer checks.
4. Each steer should be equipped with its own show halter, show stick, lead ropes and plastic comb.
5. Steers will need to be exercised daily at the fair. These requirements are in place to prevent them from being a safety hazard to you - or to others.
