Clover Leaf Barrel Pattern

- Cloverleaf Barrel Race Barrels should be the size of a 55-gallon drum, with no sharp edges. Each
 barrel should be painted so that it can be easily distinguished from the background. Protective
 devices around steel barrel tops are required.




Figure 23. Cloverleaf barrel race (patterns A and B).

- The size of the pattern (see fig. 23) should be 105 feet (35 yards) between barrels 1 and 2, 120 feet (40 yards) between barrels 2 and 3, 120 feet (40 yards) between barrels 1 and 3, and 75 feet (25 yards) from the timer to the first barrel. The course must be measured exactly.
- Riders have the option of riding course A or B.
 - Course A The entry must cross the timing line, circle barrel 1 clockwise, circle barrel 2 counterclockwise, circle barrel 3 counterclockwise and run between barrels 2 and 3 to cross the timing line.
 - Course B The entry must cross the timing line, circle barrel 2 counterclockwise, circle barrel 1 clockwise, circle barrel 3 clockwise and run between barrels 2 and 3 to cross the timing line. A 5-second penalty will be assessed for each barrel knocked down.
