#### Ottawa County Food Policy Council

- The Ottawa County Food Policy Council was formed in 2011 to address local food insecurity.
- Vision: An available supply of well-balanced meals for all

#### Food Resource Provider Forum

- ▶ In 2013, the OCFPC brought together ~25 food resource providers from throughout the county to:
  - discuss current barriers to providing food efficiently and effectively to those in need
  - brainstorm solutions to some of these barriers
  - identify ways the OCFPC could be of assistance to their agencies
  - prioritize action steps

#### Food Resource Provider Forum

- Common limitations mentioned included:
  - Not enough money
  - Lack of collaboration among pantries
  - Costs associated with purchasing food, staff time, and traveling to pick up food from the Feeding America West Michigan Food Bank
- As a result of the information shared at this forum, a collaborative project called the Holland Food Depot was born.

### **Holland Food Depot**

- Started in October 2013
- Located at the Macatawa Resource Center in Holland
- Serves as a pick-up location for local food pantries looking to stock their shelves.
- The Depot provides local pantries with a place to pick up their low-cost food orders without having to drive to the nearest Feeding America site 40+ miles away.

### **Holland Food Depot**

- Deliveries to the Food Depot take place on the third Monday of each month.
- The facility is a collaborative effort of:
  - Greater Ottawa County United Way
  - Feeding America West Michigan
  - Macatawa Resource Center
  - Community Action House
  - Ottawa County Food Policy Council

## **Participation**

- ▶ 5 pantries participated in the first depot delivery in October 2013.
- During the first year, 11 different agencies have participated in the depot.
- An average of 6.75 pantries participate at each monthly depot.

#### Cost

- Currently there is a flat delivery fee of \$200/month (Paid by Greater Ottawa County United Way)
- In 2015, the fee will decrease, as Feeding America is going to a 3 cents per pound delivery fee









# Collaboration / Communication

- This is a great example of saving time and money through collaboration.
- We have also found that the local pantries are naturally communicating more, which is a great thing!
- The project has led to other methods of collaboration between local pantries as well.
