# LARRY SEE MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

The Larry See Memorial Scholarship was established in 2013, in the memory of Larry See, who had been a 4-H member growing up in Wayne County and had served for 43 years as a leader in Monroe County. He understood and appreciated the goals of the 4-H Program, and realized that by teaching leadership and citizenship skills, our youth would become more productive citizens. By providing an annual 4-H scholarship, it is the hope that more 4-H youth have the opportunity to strive for excellence, reach their potential, and dream of setting and meeting their goals.

## ELIGIBILITY

- Candidates must be a registered member of the Monroe County 4-H Program.
- Currently a high school senior OR enrolled in a post-high school program, where you have completed not more than 1 year of the program.
- A youth is only eligible to receive this scholarship once.

## APPLICATION AND SELECTION

Applicant must:

- Submit a completed application (hard copy or electronic) to the Extension Office by April 17, 2020.
- Submit a short essay (200 words or less) on "What I have learned from being part of the 4-H program".
- Submit a headshot photo to be used in press-release.
- Provide a sealed letter of recommendation from each a high school or college faculty member AND a 4-H leader.
- Participate in an interview with the awards committee on April 22, 2020. Sign up for interview time slots will be available starting February 1, 2020 at <https://bit.ly/31xhGZm>

Selection will be set by the scholarship committee and the winners will be announced at their school honors program, where appropriate. Winners will also be encouraged to attend the Youth Recognition program at a date to be announced.

The cash award will be given when the recipient has successfully completed their first semester of school. A transcript (may be unofficial) must be sent to the Extension Office for verification by February 1, 2021.
