*: Classes in this section are required to submit photos of your project with the following angles (5): exhibitor with project, front view, back view, side profile A, and side profile B.

#: Classes in this section will require a video no longer than 90 seconds and should be continuous in nature with no narrative. The video is required to start with a close up of the animal ear tag. The exhibitor should utilize the camera person as the judge, moving their animal in front of the camera person as they would be showing their animal in the showing. The video should include all angles of the animal in order for a judge to make an evaluation. **Video must contain images of animal walking toward the camera, passing by, walking away showing rear, turn, walking showside and being set up.** The exhibitor is required to be in the video at all times. Two still photos are also required, one showing a close up of the ear tag and the second one a photo of the animal and the exhibitor. Additional information will be sent on how to upload your video and photos.

Before submitting your classes, you must upload your pictures and video. You will also declare a weight for the market classes and animal birthdates for breeding classes.

Evaluation and Awards: All classes will be evaluated using the Danish method (i.e. A, B, C). ONLY Showmanship classes will be placed with Grand and Reserve Champion designations. Cloverbuds will receive participation ribbons. Premiums will be awarded where applicable.
