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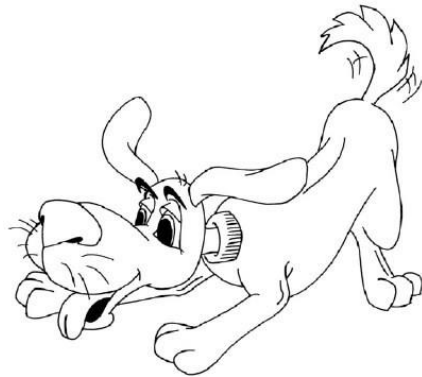
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Objectives of the 4-H Cloverbud Dog Project

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This record book was developed as a teen leadership project by Chauntel Bennett, January 2011.



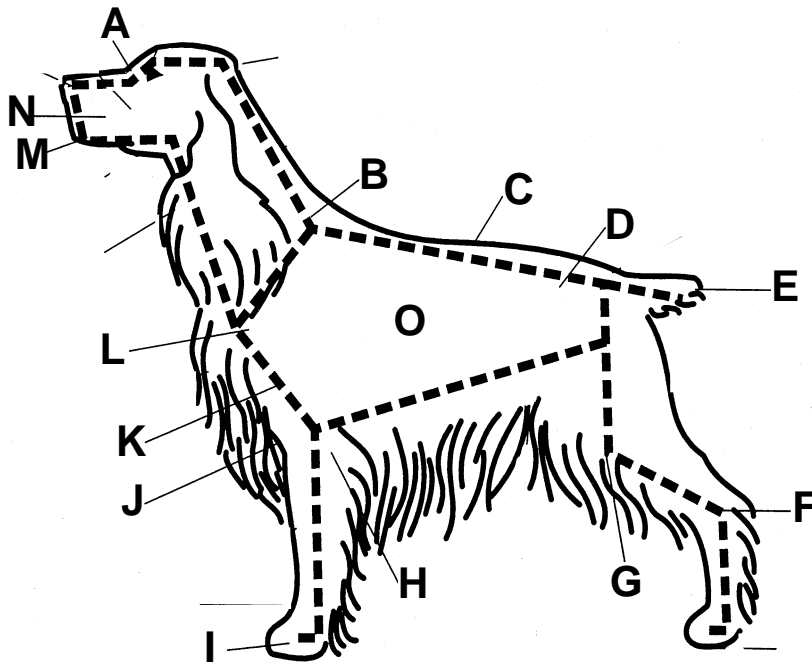
