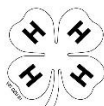

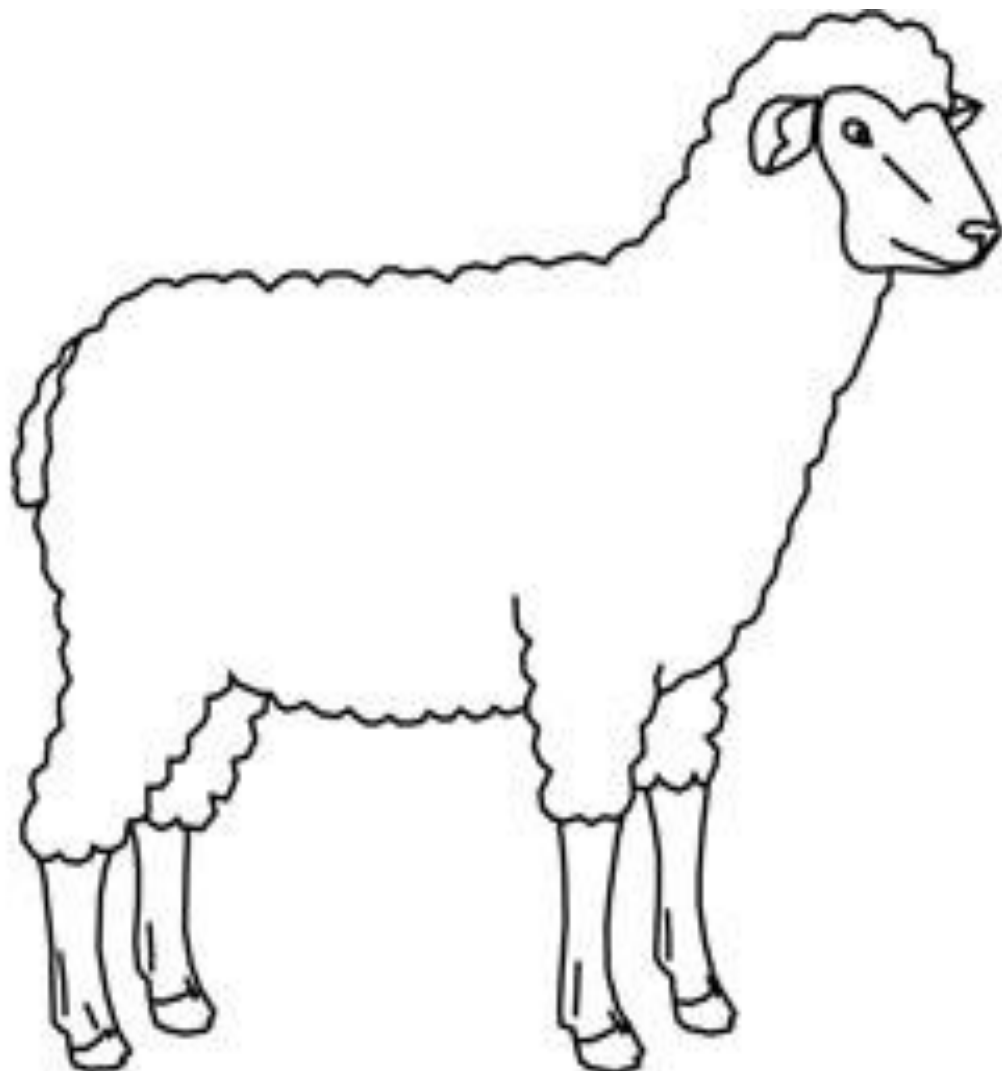

ANIMAL CARE AND MANAGEMENT- JOURNAL OF CARE

Poor Marketing Practice

	Send a picture to your potential buyers	
	Send a reminder to attend the auction	
	Let an adult talk to the buyer instead of you talking to them	
	Know the breed of your animal, if asked	
	Only ask family members to be potential buyers	
	Make sure to visit your previous buyers	
	Only thank those who agree to be listed as a potential buyer

Fore shank- Green

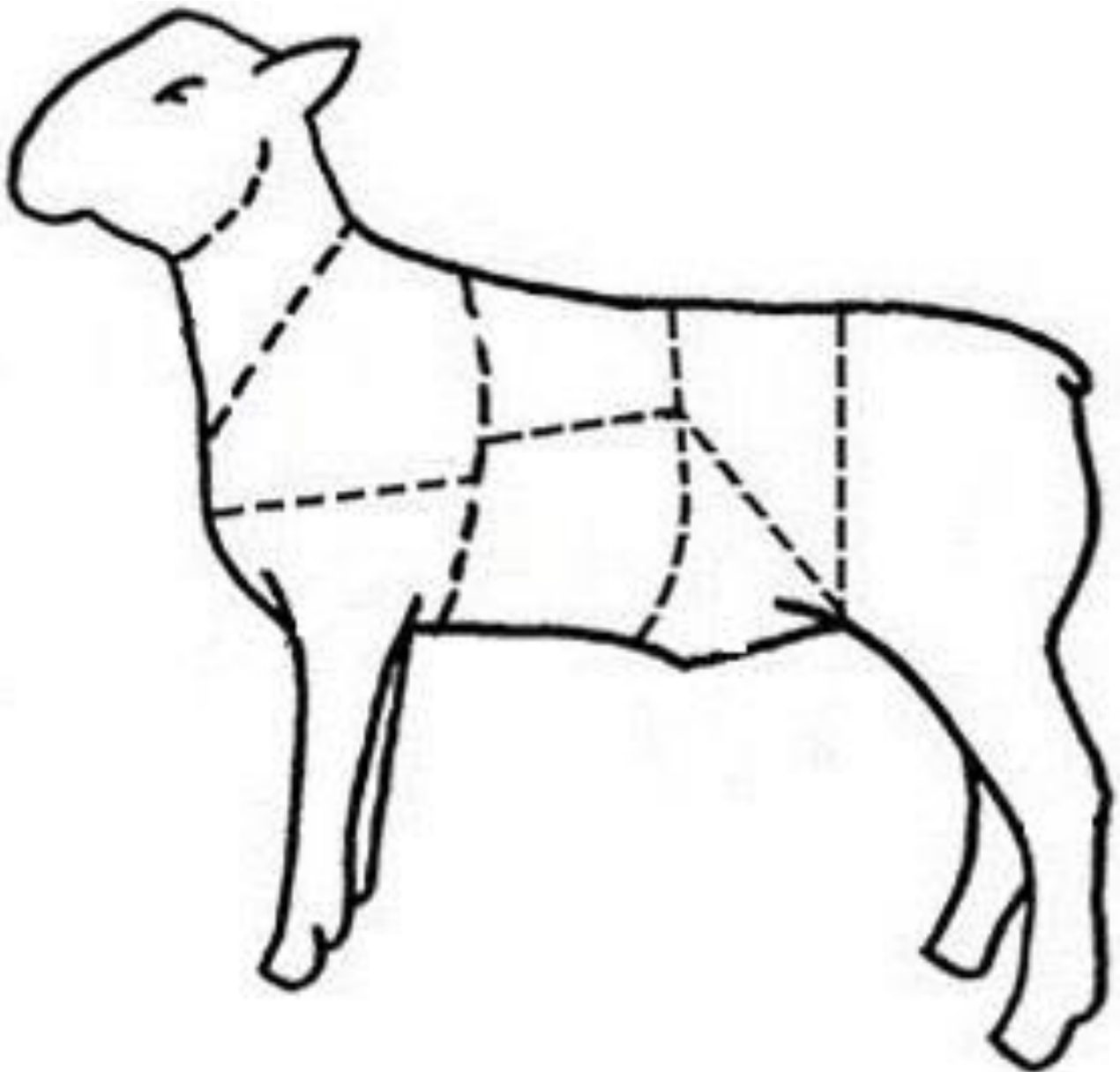
Leg- Purple

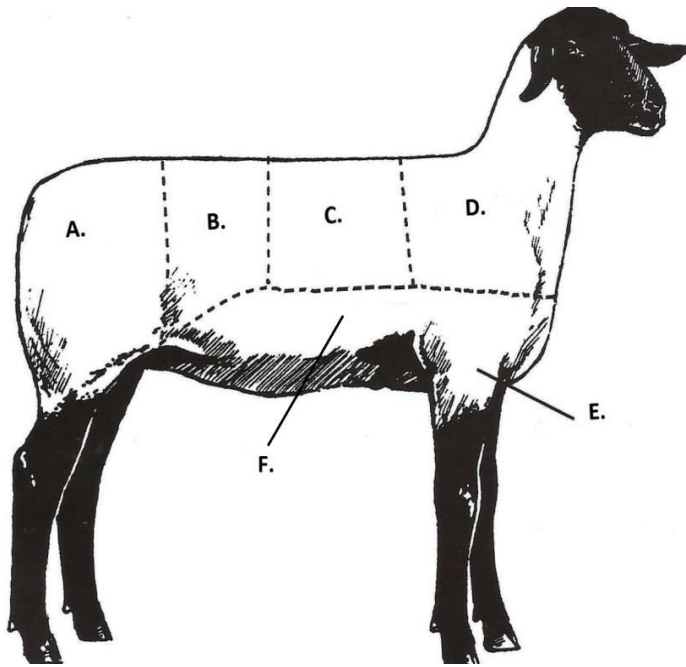



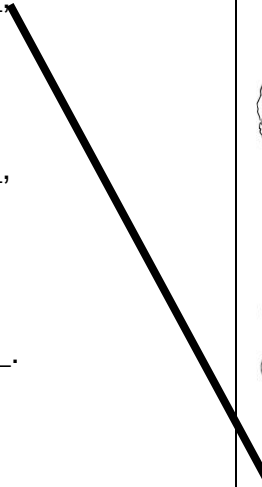
