APPLICATION TO PARTICIPATE OCEANA 4-H MARKET LIVESTOCK PROJECT SWINE

I wish to participate in the Oceana 4-H Market Livestock Swine Project.

2. I understand that I have the option of raising no more than 2 (two) hogs with one hog being designated as my exhibit, show and selling animal for the 4-H Market Livestock Auction, or other method determined by the 4-H Market Livestock Committee.
3. If I choose to raise two hogs, I will be required to pay \$5 for the second animal and acquire a second ear tag from the MSU Extension Office for this animal by January 2, 2020 at 4:00 p.m.. At the time my picture, breed and ear tags are due at the MSU Extension, I will declare which hog is my primary hog and which hog is my "backup" hog. If my primary hog should have any issues related to its health and/or show quality, I will have until August 11th (14 days prior to Fair) to provide a written notification to the MSU Extension Office that I will be using my "backup" hog. Exhibiting my "backup" hog without notification will result in disqualification from the project.
4. I understand a dollar amount and percentage of the gross sale price will be withheld by the 4-H Livestock Committee to cover expenses of the project and auction. All other expenses will be assumed by me.
5. **I understand that all enrollments will be accepted on a first come, first serve basis pending available space. If I completed the market swine project last year, and met all of the requirements listed on the 4-H Automatic Enrollment Policy, I may sign up during the time frame of 10/18/2019 – 11/1/2019 at the MSUE Office. Those who have not participated in, or completed a market swine project last year, the enrollment time frame for this project is November 9, 2019 from 8:00 a.m. to 8:15 a.m. and will resume during normal business hours (8 a.m.—12 noon & 1:00 p.m. 4:00 p.m.) Tuesday, November 12, 2019 until January 2, 2020 while space is available. Applications will be available October 17, 2019 during the Market Livestock Annual Meeting and then at the MSU Extension Office until January 2, 2020. There will be a waiting list accepting at least 5 members. Please see attached project rules/requirements for specific details on waiting list system. Space will still be limited to 60 swine.**
I understand that applications can only be submitted by the 4-H-er, parent/guardian or sibling on November 9, 2019. No other relatives may submit my application. All 4-H Enrollment Forms must be submitted through <https://mi.4honline.com> and fees must be paid before you are allowed to sign up for a market project and before any paperwork will be accepted.
6. The animal must be on feed, ear tagged, breed specified and a color picture turned into the MSU Extension Office by 4:00 p.m. on May 11, 2020. Leader's must sign pictures if tag is not visible. **NO EXCEPTIONS!** Failure to comply with this statement will result in disqualification from the project. I must also declare my primary hog (hog #1) and backup hog (hog #2) at this time if I have chosen to raise two animals.
7. This form must be signed by your 4-H Club Leader for you to participate in the project. Forms will not be accepted without proper signatures.
