Post-Secondary Scholarship Awards Program

About the Program:

Each year the Otsego County 4-H Council sponsors up to five scholarships for graduating high school senior 4-H members. Scholarships will be up to \$500 and will be paid directly to the school of applicant's choice. These scholarships are one-time only and are awarded at the discretion of the Scholarship Committee based on the application documents and interview.

Eligibility*:

- 1. Applicant must have been active in 4-H for at least three years from the age of 9 to 19.
- 2. Applicant must be a current active 4-H member in Otsego County.**
- 3. Applicant will be successfully completing their high school education and receiving a diploma in May/June of the current year.
- 4. Applicant will be entering college/trade school during the fall semesterfollowing their high school graduation.
 - *Any exception to these requirements must be requested in writing, submitted to the 4-H office, and approved by the 4-H Council.
 - **Attendance at 6 or more Club meetings per 4-H year is required for a youth to be considered an active 4-H member.

Application Process:

- 1. The applicant must submit the following documents by May 15:
 - A. This application is completed in full.
 - B. Two letters of recommendation. (1 4-H volunteer, 1 teacher/school, employer, or professional acquaintance. No relatives.)
 - C. Copy of Acceptance Letter from the college/vocational school that you plan to attend.
- 2. Submit all documents in a sealed envelope, clearly marked "Attention 4-H Council College Scholarship Application Enclosed" to the 4-H office by the deadline.
- 3. The committee will review the applications and contact eligible applicants for an interview. This will be an "in-person" interview with committee representatives.
- 4. All applicants will be notified via email or phone of the decision after the selection process is complete.
- 5. The recipients of the award must submit a confirmation of enrollment by August 1st in order for payment to be sent to the college.
- 6. If the recipient drops out of school prior to completion of the first semester, the recipient will be responsible for repayment of this awarded scholarship to the 4-H Council.
