COVID-19 Updates

- ➤ Beginning August 1st, all campus buildings will be open during regular business hours.
- ➤ Offices that have student and public facing operations are expected to be staffed beginning August 16th.
- > As of June 28th, MSU has lived most of the COVID-19 mandates to align with sate and federal guidelines.
