Formally organized in 2003, the individuals elected to the SAC committee are charged with addressing issues, concerns and opportunities on behalf of staff in CANR through direct communication to the Dean.

## CANR's College Advisory Committee (CAC)

The SAC Chair (Sharon Reasoner) represents all College support staff by attending the monthly CAC meetings. If the SAC Chair is not available to attend the co-chair (Heather Miller) will go in their absence. This ensures staff engagement at the College level. You may recall that last year the CAC approved the addition of a new college level standing committee "The Diversity, Equity and Inclusion Committee". This committee will have two staff representatives.

# **Monthly SAC Meetings**

In September of 2017 we began our year with our first meeting saying goodbye to Dave Main and thanking him for his years of service to this committee. Dave served 2 3-year terms and assisted with the staffer of the month task. We also welcomed Kevin Turner who filled the vacant spot left by Dave in zone 4. The committee meets monthly nine times per year, September – May, with email communication during the summer months when needed.

#### **Actions**

- October 2017 three applicants were invited to campus for the CANR Associate Dean for DEI position, staff participated during the interview process. Quentin Tyler began in March 2018
- In November 2017 you voted to elect your staff representation for this committee; Ali Burck (CANR Staff) and Gina Flores (MSUE Staff) will represent you on this committee, one will have a 3 year term and the other a 1.5 year term.
- November 2017 Reviewed charitable organizations internally to MSU as an alternative to support vs.
   Toys for Tots. SAC decided to support MSU Safe Place for the charitable campaign this year.
- December 2017 SAC Facebook page was closed out, we will post news worthy items on the MSU Staff Facebook page.
- February 2018 Dean Hendrick joined our meeting and updated us on the events that had taken place across campus related to the Nassar case, President Simon's resignation, and announcement of John Engler as Interim President. Open meetings were held across campus to questions.
- May 2018 SAC initiated an email to the Dean raising awareness that a staff representative serve on the search committee for the new MSU President. Ideally we would like to see a CANR staff member participate on this committee.

#### **Events**

The committee planned several successful events we'd like to highlight. They included:

- November 2017 Rolled out the first "Did You Know" reference guide on Education Assistant benefit.
- January 2018 The SAC distributed complimentary tickets to staff members to attend Michigan State
  University women's basketball games. February 1<sup>st</sup> game 59 tickets and February 21 game 102 tickets.

- February 2018 Kicked off our charitable campaign to support MSU Safe Place and replenish their supply needs. Your contributions were heart felt and generous over 416 items and \$565 dollars was donated.
