Discipline Rules: The 15th Edition of the [National Standard Three-Position Air Rifle Rules](#) shall govern, unless otherwise specified in this program.

Discipline Specific Safety Rules: All firearms must be transported to the range in a proper case; one firearm per case. No firearm will be removed from the case until directed to do so by the range officer. Clear barrel indicators (CBIs) are required ([Rule 2.2](#)). Eye and ear protection are required ([Rule 2.14.1](#)). In the case of a serious, blatant, or dangerous rifle-handling violation where the safety of another person is endangered, the athlete will be disqualified ([Rule 7.20.3](#)).

Age Divisions: Beginner (Ages 9-11), Junior (Ages 12-14), Senior (Ages 15-19). Age determination date is 1/1/2026.

Rifle Divisions: Sporter Air Rifle ([Rule 4.2](#)) or Precision Air Rifle ([Rule 4.4](#)). .177 caliber rifles only.

Sights: Telescopic sight systems are prohibited. See [Rule 4.2.8 Sights](#) and [Rule 4.5 Precision Rifle Sights](#).

Equipment: See [Rule 4.3 Sporter Clothing and Accessories](#) and [Rule 4.6 Precision Clothing and Accessories](#).

Distance: 10 meters (Rule 5.5.1)

Target: [Orion 10m Air Rifle 12 Bull Target](#) (AR 5/10)
