

The Statewide Coordinator (Sarah Winslow) and Spartan Project SEARCH Instructor (Brooke Locher) also presented to spread the word of this great program.





Applications are in and Ingham ISD hosted Skills Assessment Day for the 2024-25 cohort. It was great to see so many excited faces!


