We are in our final month of the program and it will go by in a flash! Spartan Project SEARCH interns are continuing to push themselves on jobsites acquiring employability skills and practicing workplace social interactions. Interns recently completed the first of two employment planning meetings for this final rotation, creating goals for their remaining five weeks of the program. Interns are also revisiting topics in the classroom such as disability disclosure, self-advocacy, and the process for applying for jobs of interest. We are excited that some departments within MSU have openings! Interns seeking employment will be referred for job development services offered through our partner, Michigan Rehabilitation Services (MRS). MRS will provide job follow along services for interns after employment is achieved to ensure readiness.
