<u>Translation Center</u>	“The Michigan State University Translation Center is a comprehensive language service provider. We offer high-quality and affordable translation and interpreting services in over 20 languages across the MSU community and beyond. The Center can provide training, administer language proficiency exams, and develop workshops or classes in specialized topics in a variety of languages.”
<u>RCPD Student Accommodations</u>	“The Resource Center for Persons with Disabilities (RCPD) assists students, faculty, and staff by maximizing ability and opportunity for full participation at MSU. If you are a student or employee at MSU, and you have a disability that substantially limits a major life activity, you can register with the RCPD and you may be eligible to receive accommodations.” Resources available (but not limited to) note taking, sign language and interpreting available
<u>RCPD Student Resources</u>	“As a student at MSU, you can benefit from the vast amount of campus resources and involvement opportunities. RCPD is here to help you get connected!” Resources include (but are not limited to) Health and Wellness, Online Learning, Occupational, and Scholarships”
<u>RCPD Dispute Resolutions</u>	“Though RCPD staff enjoys a reputation of fairness, compassion, and integrity, the possibility always exists for disagreements about disability determination, appropriateness of accommodations, or service quality. In the event a disagreement should arise, you are encouraged to make use of the following internal process for dispute resolution and appeal.”
<u>RCPD: DEI + Accessibility</u>	“Michigan State University is committed to providing equal opportunity for full participation in programs, services, and activities. RCPD has compiled resources that promote and advance accessibility across campus.” Resources include (but are not limited to) assertive listening devices, all gender and accessible campus restrooms, transportation and parking.
