Each semester, the Urban & Regional Planning Faculty will review URP majors who have reached 56 credits for admission into Upper Division. In addition to a CUM MSU GPA of 2.0, students must also have the equivalent course work completed in these prerequisite courses with a minimum grade of a 2.0 or higher in each course:

- Introduction to Urban & Regional Planning (UP 201)
- Computing Concepts and Competencies (CSE 101)
- Introduction to Microeconomics (EC 201)
- Introduction to American National Government (PLS 100)
- Statistical Methods (STT 201)

Please include the following with this application:

- Essay: (500 words) why did I choose the Planning Profession?
- Resume: Please include a current resume and be sure to include any and all service activities. Service includes community projects with clubs, civic, religious and other organizations and individual activities of service, philanthropic or volunteerism. Examples of service work include, but are not limited to, tree plantings, adopts a highway, earth day events, hospice visits, organizing fund raising activities for non-profit organizations, education or research, big brothers/big sisters, volunteering at animal shelters, food pantries, senior centers, youth reading programs.
