***ALL MEMBERS WILL NEED TO PROVIDE THEIR OWN RABBIT FEED!

******MEMBERS, PARENTS, and LEADERS******

- -Rabbit Clinic August 24th 1pm at the fair grounds, Rabbit Barn #29 unless its raining, then we will be under the grandstands.
- -Sunday August 10th Tattooing Rabbits 10am-1pm at the Rabbit Barn #29
- -Wednesday August 13th Tattooing Rabbits 5pm-7pm at the Rabbit Barn #29

PLEASE EACH MEMBER BRING A CLEAN TOWEL to help prevent possible transmission of any parasites/ diseases.

The towel will be used to wrap your rabbit up

While being tattooed. Each Market rabbit & breeding stock rabbit must have a tattoo in its left ear to attend fair.

If your breeding stock already has a tattoo, you do not need to bring it with you, but you MUST come and register it. Each member can register 6 market rabbits and 6 breeding stock rabbits. Market Rabbits will be crosstagged for each family member that lives in the same household. We are allowing each member to bring 1 meat pen and 2 breeding stock. Breeding stock rabbits are 1 per class, so you can't have 2 senior bucks or whatever that may be. For Clarification, please ask (Emily)

*******Friday September 12th 3pm-7pm FAIR CHECK IN*******

ALL RABBIT LEADERS NEED TO HELP! PLEASE!!!! SEE EMILY WHERE TO HELP!

- -Each rabbit must weigh at least 3lbs for a minimum of 9lbs for the whole market pen. A PEN THAT WEIGHS 17lbs OR OVER WILL BE SENT HOME. And PENS LESS THEN 9 WILL BE SENT HOME.
- -PLEASE bring carpet square or a clean towel for health check table so we don't spread disease.
- -Extra scales will be available to double check Weights, you must do this BEFORE you present your rabbits to the health check table. These scales are located at the end of the barn.
- -If one of your rabbits does not pass the health

Inspection or does not make weight, you cannot substitute a different rabbit, so do your own health check before bringing them to be checked in.

-MARKET PENS AND BREEDING STOCK WILL START WITH HEALTH CHECKS PRIOR TO BEING REGISTERED.

-There will be check in stations as there have been in the past. Each station must be initialed by staff to move on to the next step. These are to help you make sure everything is complete!

-REMEMBER TO BRING YOUR OWN RABBIT FOOD!!!!!

Saturday, September 13th Morning Chores **6-8AM**-Rabbit Barn will provide wheel barrows this year, you NOT need to bring in your own. We will be limiting how many wheel barrows come in the barn. Clean trays or bottom floor depending on where you are located in the barn. Sweep around your area, feed and water your rabbit. PLEASE MAKE SURE TO FINISH ALL CHORES BY 8AM! THIS IS NOT A STARTING TIME! CHORES MUST BE DONE EVERYDAY MORNING CLEANING FEED AND WATER. EVENING CHORES 6pm-8pm Feed and Water ONLY! This is for ALL pens of rabbits.

- Showmanship Class Attire: Black pants and white shirt and closed toed shoes. No fingernail polish or jewelry and remember if you have long hair to pull it back, so it does not hinder the judge from viewing of the animal or you.
- Market Class attire: dark pants, long sleeve shirt, no jewelry, no nail polish, no hats. Those showing horses will be allowed to borrow a white coat for their class if desired.

You will bring 1 rabbit in your carrying cage. The rabbit superintendents will be there to line you up! You must be on time and in order, so please watch and know how fast or slow its going! One of the superintendents will be writing down your buyer info and sales amounts. You will get this paper, use it to fill out the info on your cage tag. Use a black sharpie, and fill out your buyer and sale price. This needs to be completed by Thursday night chores.

After the rabbits are gone you can come get your crocks (water dish).
