Reminders

- All rabbit exhibitors will be required to feed, water and clean the cage area of their own market or breeding stock rabbits each day of fair.
- **Each individual** market rabbit must weigh at <u>least 3 lbs</u> for a minimum pen weight total of 9 lbs.
- There will be an "unofficial" set of scales available for use prior to getting in line to weigh rabbits on Friday, September 16. Please remember that you may weigh your rabbits officially only once at the rabbit barn entrance.
- ➤ <u>Kindling report:</u> Pictures must be 4"x 6". Exhibitor may use no more than two (2) Poster Boards for report.
- Dress Code for <u>Showmanship</u> classes: Long sleeve <u>White</u> shirt, Dark colored pants, Closed toe shoes. Dress code for <u>CloverBud</u>, <u>Market, and Breeding Stock</u> classes: Long Sleeve shirt, Dark colored pants, Closed toe shoes.
- Countywide Tattooing at the Fairgrounds: August 10, 2022, 5:00 8:00 p.m. and August 14, 2022, 1:00 4:00 p.m. All rabbit exhibitors <u>must</u> attend. All registration paperwork will be done at the countywide tattoo events.
- NEW Evaluations System for 2022: All livestock exhibitors will be required to complete an evaluation (interview and record book) and Skill-A-Thon for each species they exhibit. These will take place on Sunday, September 11, 2022 for rabbits.
