Re: 2023 Rabbit Project Important Information

NEW for 2023: Any market pen that is overweight will be sent home. *Exception*: rabbits may be moved to breeding stock classes where appropriate.

Reminders

- Countywide tattooing and registration will be at the Fairgrounds near the rabbit barns on Wednesday August 9, 2023, 5:00 - 7:00 p.m. and Sunday, August 13, 2023, 10:00 a.m. -1:00 p.m. All rabbit exhibitors <u>must</u> attend one of these dates.
- Each individual market rabbit must weigh <u>at least 3 lbs</u> at fair check-in. Each pen must weigh a minimum total of 9 lbs and maximum total of 17 lbs. Underweight *and overweight* pens will be ineligible to exhibit at the fair and will be sent home.
- There will be an "unofficial" set of scales available for use prior to getting in line at fair check-in on Friday, September 15, 2023. Please remember that you may weigh your rabbits <u>officially</u> only ONCE at the rabbit barn entrance.
- All rabbit exhibitors will be required to feed and water their own market or breeding stock rabbits each day between 6:00 - 8:00 a.m. and 6:00 - 8:00 p.m. Exhibitors must clean under their cage every morning.
- Dress Code for Showmanship classes: Long sleeve white shirt, dark colored pants, and closed-toed shoes. Dress code for CloverBud, Market, and Breeding Stock classes: long sleeve shirt, dark colored pants, and closed-toed shoes.
