RE: 2024 4-H Camp Counselor Application/Selection Process

Do you enjoy both the "great outdoors" and working with younger 4-H members? Then 4-H has a great opportunity for you! Summer 4-H Camp is set for June 10-12, 2024, and we're looking for qualified 4-H teens to serve as Camp Counselors!

Following are the qualifications for serving as a 4-H camp counselor:

- Must be a currently enrolled St. Joseph County 4-H member.
- Must be 15-19 years old by January 1, 2024. ٠
- Prior experience working with youth 8-12 years of age desired, but not required.
- Must be available to attend training on Saturday, April 13 and Sunday, April 14 at Amigo ٠ Centre in Sturgis. If there is a conflict, please note that on your application.
- Must be available to work full time at Summer 4-H Camp. This includes participation in ٠ camp set-up starting at 2:00 p.m. on Sunday, June 9 and continuing through the release of campers at 4:00 p.m. on Wednesday, June 12. Note: Summer 4-H Camp officially starts on Monday, June 10 at 9:00 a.m. with registration of campers.

4-H Camp Counselor Interviews will be held on Saturday, February 16, 2024 in 10-minute intervals starting at 10:00 a.m. at the St. Joseph County MSU Extension office in Centreville, and will be conducted by a three-person team.

Camp Counselor Application/Interview Process: Please complete the following two (2) application steps by no later than Friday, February 9, 2024 if you are interested in applying for a 4-H camp counselor position.

Step No. 1 - Complete and print the 4-H Camp Counselor Application Form and return it to the St. Joseph County MSU Extension office by Friday, February 9, 2024. If you mail your application, make sure you mail it early enough so it arrives at the Extension office by this deadline!

**Step No. 2** - Call the MSU Extension office at 269-467-5511 to schedule your interview.

Notification of Results of Application/Interview Process: Applicants will receive a letter indicating the outcome of the selection process following the interviews.
