

The Jim & Thelma Fairchild Volunteer 4-H Leader Award

Guidelines

- Award will be given to a volunteer 4-H leader who best demonstrates the 4-H pledge (head, heart, hands and health) as a role model.
- Awardee must have served a minimum of 5 years as a volunteer 4-H leader.
- Leader may be nominated by 4-H members, other leaders, or self-nominated by submitting one (1) page nomination form documenting how nominee demonstrates/lives the 4-H pledge.
- A selection committee of three (3) people comprised of one (1) 4-H Youth Council representative, one (1) MSU Extension staff member, and one (1) at-large member will select the recipient of the award.
- A leader is eligible to receive this award more than once.
- Award will be given annually at the Leader-Donor Recognition Banquet.
