Goat Costume Contest

Saturday, September 26, 2020, 3:00 p.m.

This is the opportunity for the youth to “dress up” their goats and themselves and have fun in the ring. It is a fun event and open to all 4-H members and their goats.

Animals must be docile and able to be handled with clothing, etc. on them.

Examples of costumes: different clover designs, how the normal/industry standard has changed for goats or other species, how show attire has changed, etc.

Rules and Regulations for the Costume Class

1. Have fun! Costume themes should be in good taste and in alignment with 4-H values. Remember the theme this year is: **4-H Through the Generations**
2. Dress up yourself and your goat in a costume; all goats can participate in one class.
3. Goats must be very gentle and able to be handled by the exhibitor once decorated.
4. There is to be no use of dye or glitter of any kind.
5. Youth must present a 3” x 5” card with their name, goat’s name, years in 4-H, club name and a brief description of the costume for both the youth and animal. This will be handed in by NOON on Saturday (for the announcer to read). There will be a sign-up sheet posted in the goat barn all week so you will have time to sign up. This sheet will be taken down Saturday morning....so make sure you sign up and get your 3” x 5” card filled out and turned in by 12:00 noon.
6. 4-H current goat project member may have additional help from another St. Joseph County 4-H member or registered Cloverbud.

Placings: There will be placings for 1st, 2nd, 3rd and Honorable Mention
