Western High Point Award

- A. Members must be enrolled and participate in the Western Dressage program and must show in at least one Western Dressage class at the St. Joseph County Fair.
- B. Points will be award from placing in Western Horsemanship, Bareback Horsemanship, Western Pleasure, Reining, Ranchmanship, Ranch Pleasure and all Western Dressage tests at the St Joseph County Grange Fair.
- C. Not all classes need to be entered to qualify.
- D. Points will be awarded as follows and are not pro-rated:
 - Eight points for first
 - Seven points for second
 - Six points for third
 - Five points for fourth
 - Four points for fifth
 - Three points for sixth
 - Two points for seventh
 - One point for eighth
- E. In the case of a tie, the winner be determined based on the highest total points in the dressage classes.
- F. Exhibitor/horse combination may not receive this award any two consecutive years.
- G. Walk/Trot classes are eligible for this award.
