RE: 2020 4-H Youth Council Election Results

I am writing to share the results of the 2019 4-H Youth Council election. A total of 414 ballots were mailed. Eligible voters included all active 4-H leaders in 2019 and all active 4-H members who will be 15-19 years old in 2020 who have completed a minimum of two (2) years in 4-H.

A total of 23 ballots were returned. The returned ballots represent a 5.6% rate-of-return, which is down from the 14.7% return rate realized in the 2019 election.

The following adult leaders and 4-H members have been elected to serve two-year and one-year terms:

East Half: Needed to fill three (3) adult representative positions and three (3) teen representative positions.

- Connie Myers (adult representative), two-year term appointed from East Half
- Regan Barrington (teen representative), one-year term appointed from East Half
- Rachel Eggleston (teen representative), one-year term
- Bree Seekman (teen representative), one-year term appointed from East Half
