<b>Horse &amp; Pony Record:</b> Must include current year record & stable card, 4H-1072 & 4H-1073. (10 points maximum)		
<b>Fifth Year Requirements:</b> Including reports, summaries, samples and collections. (40 points maximum; each category worth 5 points ea.)  - How to buy & store feed and grain - Proper barn & pasture management - Feeds & feeding of horses at different ages - Two more horse breeds - How to transport a horse safely - Techniques of loughing and ground driving - Mare care during gestation - Halter breaking a foal		
<b>Completion:</b> Was the notebook completed, done by the 4-Her. Project suited to age & years of experience of member. (10 points maximum)		
<b>Neatness:</b> Outside cover neat & attractive. Papers neatly arranged, numbered and indexed by year. Handwriting or typing neat. Pictures, pamphlets & brochures fastened. (20 points maximum)		
<b>Extra Credit:</b> (5 points)
