






Broiler Chick Pick-Up

Monroe 4H Hippology Team headed to Nationals

On the morning of Saturday, April 22nd, 4 awesome young ladies represented Monroe County 4-H as a Senior Hippology team in the State Equine Educational Expo. The team consisted of Alicia Bondar and Rachele Cate from Denim n Dust 4-H club and Matti Barnier and Paige Funchion from Whispering Spirits 4-H club, coached by Elizabeth Kotus project/co-leader also from Whispering Spirits. The Expo includes several different equine themed contests. These include public speaking, horse quiz bowl and the hippology contest. This brings kids from all over the state to participate in the cloverbud, Junior, 9-13 and Senior, 14-19 categories. In the Hippology contest, all things equine are considered fair game. The senior level contest took most of the day and included 2 horse judging classes, a written exam, 2 different picture identification sessions, and 2 different topics presented as a speech with a four members of the team giving the demonstration. During the awards presentation later that day our talented team was delighted to find out they came in first place! Along with the honor of first place Hippology team, these folks now get the chance to represent the State of Michigan at National 4-H educational round up contest held in Louisville, Kentucky in November. What a huge accomplishment. Congratulations to all!

Educational tip: What is Hippology?

Hippology is the title of an Equine Veterinary and Management Knowledge Contest that is used in 4-H, FFA, and many horse breed contests. Hippology consists of four phases: Horse Judging, Written Examination and Slide Identification, ID Stations and Team Problem Solving.

What is a Junior Superintendent? A Junior Superintendent is assigned to each 4-H department section at Fair, including Produce, Educational, Crafts, Communications, Large Animal, Small Animal, Horses, etc. The Junior Superintendents assist the adult Superintendent in each category perform tasks to ensure a successful presentation, be a runner, and/or attach project tags, ribbons, etc.

Who is eligible? Any 4-Her who is 12+ 4-H age.

When do I have duties?

Crafts, Educational: Thursday and Friday prior to Fair AND Monday after Fair

<u>Communications</u>: Thursday and Friday prior to Fair, occasionally during Fair week, AND Monday after Fair

<u>Small Animals, Goats, Large Livestock, Horse</u>: animal check-in and check out, during the week according to species

Produce/Horticulture: Thursday, Friday, Saturday prior to Fair AND Monday after Fair

Is there an incentive? YES! Each Junior Superintendent will receive a name badge. This will allow you to check your static projects in early on Thursday prior to Fair. Additionally, this is a great leadership opportunity to put on a resume.

How do I sign up? Complete the registration form below and return it to the MSU Extension Office via email or mail as listed on the form. If you have an area of preference, please make that indication.

Will I know where I get placed? Yes, each Junior Superintendent will get a confirmation email or phone call with placement.


