What is the significance of the 4 H's?

<b>HEAD</b>	4-H helps to teach kids leadership skills in thinking, learning and problem-solving.
<b>HEART</b>	4-H helps kids learn how to build relationships with peers and adults that are based on respect and care.
<b>HANDS</b>	4-H teaches kids how to use the hands-on approach and to later use their talents and skills to make their communities better.
<b>HEALTH</b>	4-H teaches kids how to make healthy choices physically and mentally at home, in school and in their community.

**4-H offers kids ages 5-19 (based on their age as of January 1 of the current year) fun learning opportunities through clubs, after-school programs and local, state, national and international events.\* All kids must be registered with a 4-H club by April 1<sup>st</sup> of the current year to participate in that year's fair.**
