The old evaluations are a great tool to help you keep good records and learn a few things along the way. The answers are found in the booklets listed above and will come from a combination of them all.

- O What is the fairbook hatch dates for chickens and turkeys for this years fair?
- o If a hatchery participates with NPIP, what disease are the chicks certified to be free of?
- What is the protein content of the turkey feed listed in the raising turkeys booklet?
- O What is the proper way to hold a chicken?
- O What is the proper way to put a chicken in or out of a cage?
- Know at least two defects that you should look for when selecting your market chickens to take to the fair?
- Be able to list two breeds of ducks,
- Be able to list two breeds of geese.
- o Know the name of a male and female goose
- Know two external parasites that affect poultry.
- Know what the term withdrawal period is.
- Clean feeders and waterers help prevent coccidiosis, black head and round worms.
