- _____ 6.) Broken tooth.

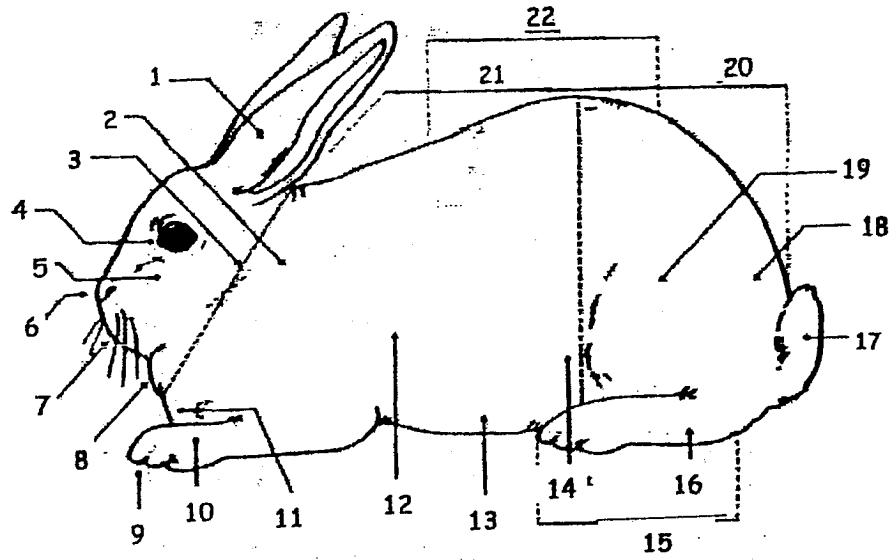
