Carcass Contest Form Instructions

1. Pick up a packet appropriate to the species you are selling:
 - a. Beef
 - b. Sheep/Hog

2. Instruct the buyer to fill out the following information. Each buyer will need their own copy of each form (cut-up sheet and buyer agreement); do not submit forms with multiple buyers on one sheet.
 - a. Cut-up sheet for Jones Farm Market and Carcass Contest
 - b. Buyer Agreement for the Jr Livestock Association Sale
 - i. Please make sure to include **youth name** and **tag number** in the appropriate species box under Jones Farm Market.
 - ii. Please write "**CARCASS**" in the upper right hand corner of the form.
 - iii. Carcass beef may be split between four (4) buyers for JLA Sale billing purposes. Carcass sheep and hogs may be split between two (2) buyers for JLA Sale billing purposes. If you have more than 2 buyers for sheep and hogs or 4 buyers for beef, you must submit the Buyer Agreement form as a buyer's group with one identified responsible individual for billing (example: Jane Smith has 6 buyers for her steer, so she lists Jane Smith's Buyers Group as the name for advertising and her father, John Smith, lists himself and his contact information as the responsible party and will be responsible for submitting one payment).

3. Please let buyers know that they have to submit payment for the animal at the market carcass prices (will be posted prior to fair on the JLA website) to the Back 4-H Office by 5 p.m. the Friday following the sale (next day) and the processing fees for the animal at Jones when you pick up the meat.

4. Turn in all forms to the carcass contest superintendent when the animal is unloaded at the fairgrounds. The carcass contest superintendent will turn in the forms to Jones Farm Market and the Back 4-H Office as appropriate.
