An EPA-approved Worker Protection Standard Video for Agricultural Workers

Help Workers Protect Themselves is a video designed to train agricultural workers according to the recently instituted Worker Protection Standard regulations.

This professionally produced 19 minute video portrays the employer as a responsible, caring individual looking out for the best interest of employees. At the same time, it fulfills the EPA educational requirements for agricultural workers under the Worker Protection Standard regulations.

Help Workers Protect Themselves is a complete training tool for agricultural workers. The only additional requirement will be to answer specific questions following the video presentation.

The video covers the eleven criteria for EPA-WPS approved training in a clear and concise manner using a variety of farm scenes and situations. It provides simple but effective training for a wide variety of agricultural workers.

Topics covered include:

- + Where and in what form pesticides may be encountered.
- + Hazards of pesticides.
- + Routes through which pesticides may enter the body.
- + Symptoms of common types of pesticide poisonings.
- + Emergency first aid for pesticide injuries or poisonings.
- + How to obtain emergency medical care.
- + Decontamination procedures, including eye flushing techniques.
- + Hazards from chemigation and drift.
- + Warnings about taking pesticides or pesticide containers home.
- + An explanation of the WPS requirements including: application, entry restrictions, design of the warning sign, posting of warning signs, oral warnings, availability of specific information about applications, and protection against retaliatory acts.


