



# What to Look For Example

1. Number each photo you take.	<b>Photo #</b>	2. Write the address or GPS location number (if used) in the address box.

Check the box that indicates the <b>MAIN</b> barrier in your photo. <b>CHECK ONLY ONE BOX PER COLUMN!</b>	<input checked="" type="checkbox"/> <b>Street Crossings</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• No Marked Crossing</li><li>• Too much traffic</li><li>• Traffic too fast</li><li>• No pedestrian signals at light</li><li>• Signals don't work</li><li>• Curb ramps missing</li></ul>
