UT - A large and good quality crop. Growers have already exceeded estimate by 11 million pounds. Harvest will probably finish with Week 7. The cherries are still scoring very well.

WI - Quality has been generally very good. Growers are picking to their estimates. Harvest will continue at least through Week 7 and maybe longer.
