

Fishes of the Grand River: Pros and Cons of Dam Removal

Saturday, August 24, 2013



The Grand River is home to over 100 species of fish. This includes threatened lake sturgeon and river redhorse that spawn below the Sixth Street Dam. The dam blocks upstream movement of many native fish, but also blocks invasive species that could damage upstream habitats and Lake Michigan. Participants will learn to identify several fish species and observe how they utilize a variety of river habitats in downtown Grand Rapids.

We will begin the class with a presentation at the Kent/MSU Extension office and proceed to a walking tour of the Grand River in downtown at the Fish Ladder Park. If water clarity is good in August we will observe fish without netting them. We will walk the bridges and fish ladder overlook downtown, and stop at several spots to discuss aspects of dam removal such as fish passage, recreational access, and stream function. Polarized sunglasses are recommended.
