# EQUIPMENT



Sugar beets have a long history in Michigan. Above is a horse drawn beet lifter.



Currently used beet harvestors generally lift 4-6 rows at a time.

#### HARVEST



This is a typical beet harvesting operation.



Tractor driven loader carts are also used to collect beets and transfer to trucks for transport.

## PROCESSING



Sugar beets are transported either to piling grounds or to processing plants.



Beets are elevated into piles until they can be processed.

### **PILING GROUNDS**



This is a typical sugar beet pile.



The beets remain in these piles into the winter, until they are processed into sugar. Processing is completed in March.
