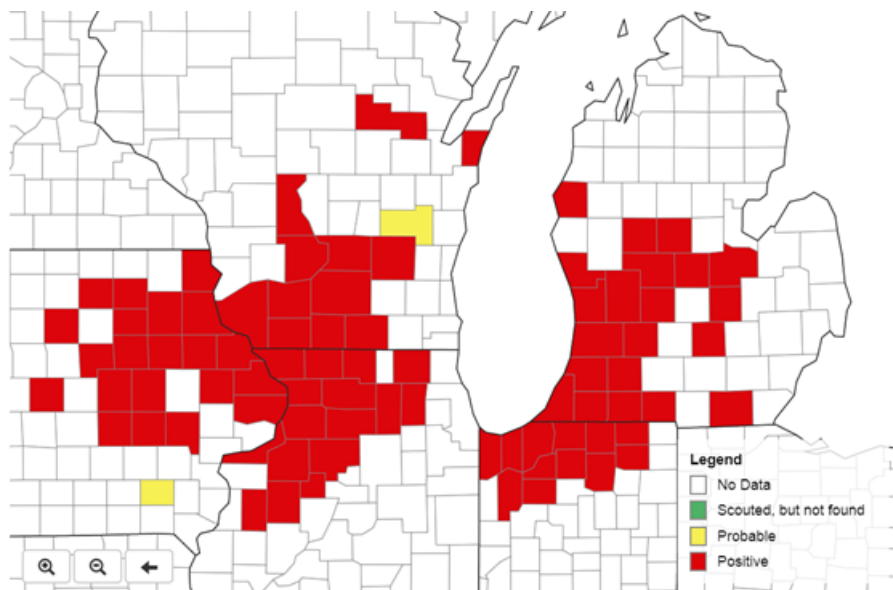
Tar Spot has once again been active in west Michigan Corn Fields. MSU Extension is hosting a field research site field day on September 18 to provide growers the opportunity to walk through the fungicide trial plots and to learn more about the disease. Dr. Chilvers will discuss tar spot incidence and severity in 2019, how weather conditions impacted the development of the disease this season and what yield impacts we might expect on irrigated and dry land fields.

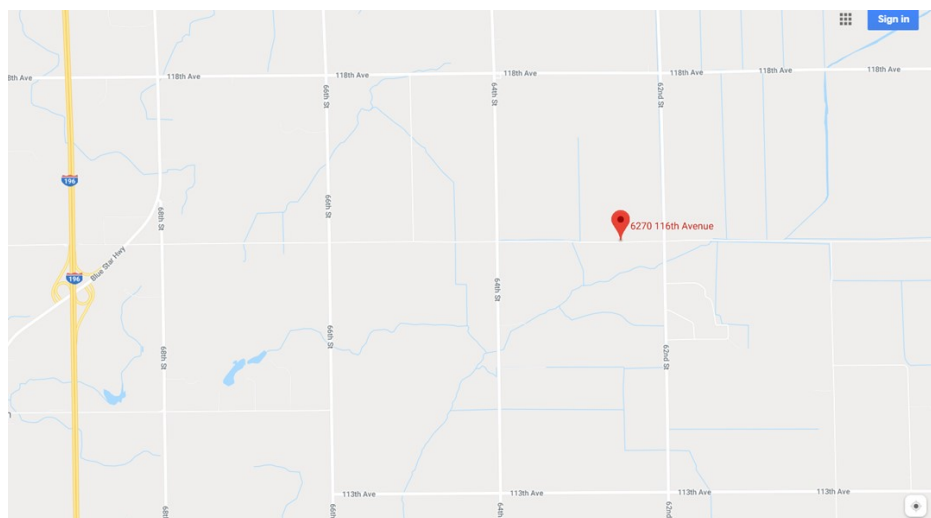
