

# 2019 4-H Youth Show Registration Information

Welcome to the 4-H Youth Show Registration Process! This event is for any youth aged 5-19 as of Jan. 1.

## 4-H Youth Show Registration has 2 parts:

1. Mandatory online registration is only open May 1-June 24 (**No Late Entries accepted!**) at the following website: <https://www.BlueRibbonFair.com/BRFairProd/BlueRibbonStart.aspx?ID=1893>.
2. Youth fees and animal pen forms and fees are due to the MSUE/4-H office anytime until June 25 at 4:30 pm

## Individual Club/Independent Registration

- **NO LATE REGISTRATIONS WILL BE ACCEPTED.**
- **4-H Member Registration Deadline** - 4-H Club Members must enroll at 4HOnline by June 1 and pay \$20 annual fee, checks made out to MSU and delivered/mailed to the 4-H office.
- If necessary, online registrations may be completed at the Washtenaw County MSU Extension/4-H offices by appointment weekdays from 8am-4:30pm\* May 1st - June 25. Contact Kellie (734-222-3815 or [jordankj@msu.edu](mailto:jordankj@msu.edu)) to schedule an appointment. (\*Let us know at least a week ahead if additional accommodations are needed outside of these hours!)
- If an exhibitor is in more than one club, they must complete 4-H Youth Show entry process and payment only one time and under one club for all exhibits and projects, **not separately for each club**.
- We recommend each exhibitor (Individual 4-H members, Independent 4-H members, and club entries) print or save a copy of your online registration from the confirmation screen (completed May 1 - June 25) for your reference. Some club leaders require these. Check with your leader.
- Showmanship is **required** for all animal classes.
- Leaders/club when registering your 4-H Club for classes at the 4-H Youth Show, separately register the 4-H Club Name, and the 4-H Leaders address and birthdate (any birth year over 21 is fine!)if necessary. Club classes to pre-register for include: Club Booth Display, Herdsmanship and/or club educational exhibits.

## Payments to deliver to MSUE offices anytime until June 25 at 4:30 pm

- **Club members pay to club, then one club check payable to:** Washtenaw 4-H Youth Show.
- **\$2 Entry Fee per each youth Exhibitor form** – Not per project and no fee for a 4-H club entry form.
- **Animal Pen Fees** – One check per club using fee summary sheet (form A) and livestock pen count sheet (form B). Combine all fees for the club on form A and make one check per club,
- **Livestock Pen Count** – See animal pen summary sheet (Form B) please be as accurate as possible. Do NOT overestimate. Space is limited. These forms are used by Staff, Superintendents and others.

- **Still Projects Set-up & Tear Down**
- **Kitchen Volunteers (ALL clubs must send volunteers!)**

## General Information

- **Exhibitor numbers** and pre-filled exhibitor tags will be provided prior to the Youth Show.
- "Still projects" (most non-animal projects) are judged using a Danish judging system which takes place on the first Sunday of the 4-H Youth Show in July. Members are expected to be present for this day of judging and to take projects back to the club table in building "A" after judging.
- **Youth Show Books** - 1 youth show book is provided to each club. **Additional copies are \$5** from 4-H/MSUE office or free at [https://www.canr.msu.edu/washtenaw/washtenaw\\_county\\_4\\_h/youthshow](https://www.canr.msu.edu/washtenaw/washtenaw_county_4_h/youthshow).
- **Horse Registration Forms** and sponsorships are **due by May 1 (or 1<sup>st</sup> business day)** to the MSU Extension Office. We are open until 4:30 pm., M-F, and closed from 12:30-1:30 pm.
