Washtenaw County 4-H Ambassador Responsibilities:

4-H Ambassadors are responsible for representing and promoting Washtenaw County 4-H at community events and assisting with county-wide 4-H activities. A calendar of events giving an idea of the planned activities will be distributed after selection has been made. Ambassador meetings will be held monthly- on average- throughout the year to allow for training and time to plan events.

Group Activities May Include:

Ambassador Retreats, Youth Show miscellaneous jobs, Recognition Luncheon, officer training, new ambassador selection, Youth Show auction, honors awards presentation at Youth Show and 4-H Advisory Council Meetings.

Individual Activities May Include:

Speaking to school groups about 4-H, presentations at public areas such as theaters or malls, speaking to 4-H clubs to promote the Ambassador program to youth at 4-H club meetings, participating in community parades and fairs, and presenting ribbons and doing announcements, and general help assignments, during the Youth Show.

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
