History of the Product Center

- Created in 2003
- Base funding provided by Extension and MSU AgBioResearch (Experiment Station)
- Since 2004 Product Center clients have created 995 jobs and retained an additional 465.
- They have also invested \$316.7 million in the state.

Venture Development

- Innovation Counselors Located throughout the state, primarily local extension personnel.
- Work individually with entrepreneurs, generally small firms.

HI-VAT

- High Impact Venture Action Team
- Works with established firms on larger projects
- Generally work is carried out by campus staff

Cooperatives

 We are also a cooperative development center and work with a wide range of coops.
